| 4 | | Dehydration and exhaustion. | Students could faint or experience headaches. | High | Ensure students move around at an appropriate pace. Ensure plenty of fluids are available and take breaks. Advise staff of potential risks to assist with supervision. | Low |
| 5 | | Electrical hazard with portable electrical equipment/static appliance and water. | Students could experience serious injury or an electrical shock. | Extreme | Staff to monitor and explain to students that water and drinks are not stored on or near electrical equipment. 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In assessing the level of risk, considerations such as the likelihood of an incident happening in combination with the seriousness of a consequence are used to gauge the overall risk level for an activity. The matrix below has been used as a guide to assist with developing the risk assessment:
