Extreme	Ensure students are wearing appropriate personal protective equipment, such as a hat and sunscreen, to maximise coverage of skin. Ensure plenty of fluids are available. 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In assessing the level of risk, considerations such as the likelihood of an incident happening in combination with the seriousness of a consequence are used to gauge the overall risk level for an activity. The matrix below has been used as a guide to assist with developing the risk assessment:
