## What you will need:

- Two long strips of different coloured paper  
(Each should be the width of a ruler, and the longer the piece of paper the better!)
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- String

## Follow these steps:

1. Lay one strip of paper vertically in front of you.
2. Take your second strip of paper and place it horizontally to make an L shape with the first strip of paper then glue the strips together.
3. Now it is time to concertina fold the paper! The vertical strip of paper will be folded up and down, and the horizontal paper will be folded side to side.
4. Take the first strip of paper and fold it down over the second paper, all the way down to the edge and press down crease. You should have a backwards Z now.
5. Take the second strip of paper, and fold it over the first strip, all the way to the edge and press down the crease. You will have a backwards L now.
6. Repeat these steps by now folding the first strip back up, the second strip back across, and keep repeating until it looks like you have an accordion. This will be the body of your snake!
7. When you get to the end of your paper, glue it down so the body of your snake doesn't come apart.
8. Add on a head, tongue and tail using paper, googly eyes.
9. Cut a 50cm length of string. Attach one end of the string towards the a few centimeters from the end of the tail, and the other just behind the snakes head.
10. Using two hands, hold the string and practice moving one hand up and the other down. You can now make your snake dance!
